Bell said 40% of the estimated revenue for the 5-year TSPLOST will be generated by people from outside of Spalding County who are visiting or shopping here. "Improved transportation brings economic development and a better quality of life," Bell added. "It is the right thing to do in paving our dirt roads," he said. "They are safer to motorists but also to first responders, school bus drivers, and children." Peters said that the TSPLOST is an excellent way to maintain and our transportation infrastructure. improve "Maintenance now will prove less expensive than later," he added. Randy asked that those attending consider donating to the TSPLOST Citizens Committee. "We need funds to print signs, flyers, and send targeted mailings to those citizens living on roads and streets to be targeted for improvement with this TSPLOST," he said. Wilson asked that everyone get out to vote. Bell and Peters asked that all vote in favor of passage of the TSPLOST as an investment in our infrastructure and future.

## **GRIFFIN ROTARY: MAKING A DIFFERENCE**

## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM **TSPLOST on November Ballot**

Our November 7<sup>th</sup> ballot will provide those voters in Griffin and Spalding County the choice to impose a One-Cent Special Option Sales Tax in support of transportation projects in Griffin, Sunnyside, Orchard Hill, and throughout the county. William Wilson, Spalding County Manager, explained that this is the first time that counties in the state have been allowed to vote on a transportation SPLOST. And, Spalding will be among 16 counties voting on TSPLOST proposals this coming Election Day. In fact, early voting has already begun. TSPLOTs are limited to 5 years. If approved, the city will receive 65% of the revenue with the county receiving the remaining amount. The City Commission and the County Commission worked together to develop a list of transportation projects that will be funded by the TSPLOST. These include paving existing dirt roads, resurfacing
